# Nature of Project: Explain current issue and how the solution is addressed through this capital request (identify if proposed expenditure is in 20 year fleet & equipment plan)

The 20-year Operations Equipment Replacement Plan has identified the need to replace one light truck in 2024. In 2023 the 2011 Ford 1/2 Ton (Truck 6) was surplused at public auction as it had reached over 200,000 kms and was no longer reliable. This truck was used primarily by Parks & Facilities staff to transport students and small equipment for parks maintenance. Currently only 1 Operations truck has four (4) passenger seating which limits the capacity and, hence, the transportation of staff. The replacement truck is proposed to be a base model Crew Cab with a long box and box cover for security of equipment.

The Municipality only has one single 4 passenger vehicle as the other was surplused last year, causing two vehicles to attend some sites to appropriately conduct work. The current vehicle being replaced is 12 years old and has high mileage. It is expected that maintenance and repairs will continue to rise in the operating budget if not replaced.

## Alternatives: Present options to the issue and also address any provisional items that would form part of the tender

The Operations Department does currently have one underused truck which is a 1-Ton standard cab 2011 Chevrolet, however, it is equipped with a dump box for winter use and is not suitable for the movement of more than 2 staff members. It does not meet the needs of the Operations Department.

This truck would be considered an addition to the assets in the capital asset management plan as the truck it is replacing was disposed from the assets in 2023. Council should expect a minimal increase in the overall financial burden of maintenance and replacement.
