

NOTICE: REVISIONS TO VOTERS' LIST for the 2022 Municipal Election



The Voters' List for the 2022 Municipal Election in Callander will be produced as of September 1st. Any eligible voter may apply to the Municipal Clerk's Office to add, delete, or change their own information on the Voters List as follows:

IN WRITING: As per the Municipal Elections Act (MEA), all applications to amend the Voters' List must be in writing. **Please use the Application Form available from the Municipal Office or the elections page on our website: www.mycallander.ca/en/local-government/elections.** Revisions can be made starting on September 1, 2022 and ending at the close of voting on Voting Day, October 24, 2022.

HOW TO SUBMIT:

- You can hand the form in at the Municipal Office, 280 Main Street North, Callander, during regular business hours from 8:30am to 4:30pm, Monday to Friday (holidays excepted).
- You can have someone else (your "agent") bring the form to the office for you. The form must have your original signature on it and your agent must also sign the form and provide their contact information and proof of identity*.
- You can send the form by regular mail with a copy of your proof of identity, but it must bear your original signature. Please note: you are responsible for ensuring your application to add or amend the Voters' List reaches the office in sufficient time if you wish for a vote by mail kit to be issued.
- You can email the form, but it must be signed and you must email proof of identity with it.
- You can bring a completed form with you, or you can get a form and fill it out at the Voting Place on Voting Day: Monday, October 24 from 10:00 am to 8:00 pm, at the Callander Community Centre on Swale St. You will need to sign the application form and produce proof of identity*.

Approval or Refusal of the Application

The Municipal Clerk or designate must be satisfied that the applicant is entitled to have the requested change made. If so, he or she shall approve and certify the application form and return one copy to you to notify you that the application has been approved. If the application is refused, the Clerk or designate shall return a copy of the form to you explaining why it was refused.

Removal of Others' Names

You can only apply to remove someone else's name from the Voters' List if that person is deceased. No application form is not required, but satisfactory proof of death must be provided to the Municipal Clerk.

Municipal Clerk's decision final

As per Section 26 of the MEA, the Municipal Clerk's decision to approve/refuse an application is final.
