Casual/On-Call Employment Opportunity Equipment Operator/Labourer

The successful candidate will be a dynamic, outgoing individual with a minimum of five years' work experience as a snowplow/equipment operator. This is a casual/on-call position which provides additional coverage during winter maintenance and road repair projects. The candidate would be considered if a full-time permanent position becomes available.

The Operations Equipment Operator/Labourer reports directly to a Supervisor and would carry out the winter/summer maintenance and construction activities on roads, bridges, parks and recreational facilities and other duties as directed.

The successful candidate will be responsible for the operation of public works equipment, used for the maintenance and construction of municipal roadways and facilities, which includes but is not limited to: Backhoe, Grader, Wheel loader, Dump Truck, Snowplow, Sander, Steamer and Sidewalk Machine.

Qualifications

- Successful completion of a Secondary School Diploma or equivalent approved combination of education and experience.
- A minimum of five years' experience as a tandem dump/snowplow operator.
- Working knowledge of winter road maintenance and Maintenance Standards,
- Valid Ontario Class "DZ" driver's license free of serious offences under the Highway Traffic Act.
- Ability to perform manual labour work in potentially adverse weather conditions.
- Ability to work outside regular business hours as required.
- First Aid, CPR, WHIMIS Certification is desired
- Propane Handling Certificate and Chainsaw Certification would be an asset

A valid driver's License, acceptable driving record, and clean criminal record check will be required prior to hire.
